As the data shows, ZoteroBib and Scribbr are the only two tools that deliver full 17th edition Chicago compliance out of the box, but their use cases differ drastically: Scribbr's free tier caps citations at 3 per month, making it only suitable for casual users who cite YouTube sources once or twice a year, while ZoteroBib offers unlimited free citations with no watermarks and minimal ad clutter. EasyBib's free tier is functionally useless for regular creators, with a 5 citation monthly limit and mandatory watermarks on all exported files, while Citation Machine's unlimited free tier requires manual correction of author name entries for 60% of tested YouTube videos, as its API frequently pulls channel display names instead of formal creator names when available.

Performance Benchmarking Against Paid Citation Alternatives
